*** Teams traveling from Lucknow or Varanasi by road may get down at BINA BUS STAND .- (near SBI BINA) which is 0.5 km from the school.**

*** The teams suppose to reach early morning of 19th October must inform in advance through mail or telephonic call for necessary arrangements related to fooding and lodging.**

RULES & REGULATIONS TO CONDUCT THE TOURNAMENT

1. All the teams shall be accompanied by a teacher / coach / manager designated by the participating school Principal.
2. No team will be permitted to participate without accompanying team manager / coach.
3. No team shall be accompanied by any parent. However, if a parent is accompanying the team, in lieu of a coach / manager such information may be provided by the school on the school letter head.
4. No team shall be accompanied by more than two officials.
5. The officials accompanying the team shall have a valid identity card issued by their school Principal.
6. No extra person shall be permitted to stay inside the school premises and on the play field along with the teams.

CONDUCTING OF MATCHES

7. All the matches shall be played according to the rules of AIFF.
8. A team shall consist of maximum 18 players. No players shall be allowed to take part in the tournament without proper kit.
9. All the matches shall be played on knock-out basis. In case of draw , no extra time will be given.
10. In case of draw, winner of the match shall be decided on the basis of penalty kicks.
11. If the score remains same after the penalty kicks, the result of the match will be decided on **sudden death**.
12. Maximum five players can be substituted in a game.
13. Decision of the game referee will be final.
14. Every team will carry its school flag for the purpose of March past to be used during the various ceremonies.
15. Participation in March past is compulsory.
16. All the participating teams for March past shall come in the prescribed school uniform.

MANDATORY

17. Team photo with the Principal along with entry Proforma countersigned by the concerned Principal at the time of reporting.
18. Documents for verification, in original, if asked for.
19. CBSE Registration number of student / player studying in class IX.
20. Participants studying in Class-XI & XII must bring their Class-X Certificate with photo issued by the Board.
21. Signed copy of the eligibility proforma duly filled in.

ADMINISTRATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

22. Consumption of liquor , drugs , tobacco and smoking is strictly prohibited during the tournament and stay in the school. Anyone who violates this rule will be asked to leave the school campus immediately.
23. Any damage done to the property of the school during the stay by the participants will have to be compensated for by the respective team manager / coach.
24. Players are not allowed to bring any costly ornament and valuable articles. The school will not be responsible for

- the loss of any article during their stay. Locks should be brought by the teams.
25. Team manager will be responsible for the conduct of the team on the field and on the school premises.
26. Medical check-up may also be advised by the Jury of Appeal or appointed persons in case of overage suspicion.

DISQUALIFICATION:

27. A team / player may be disqualified for the following reasons:

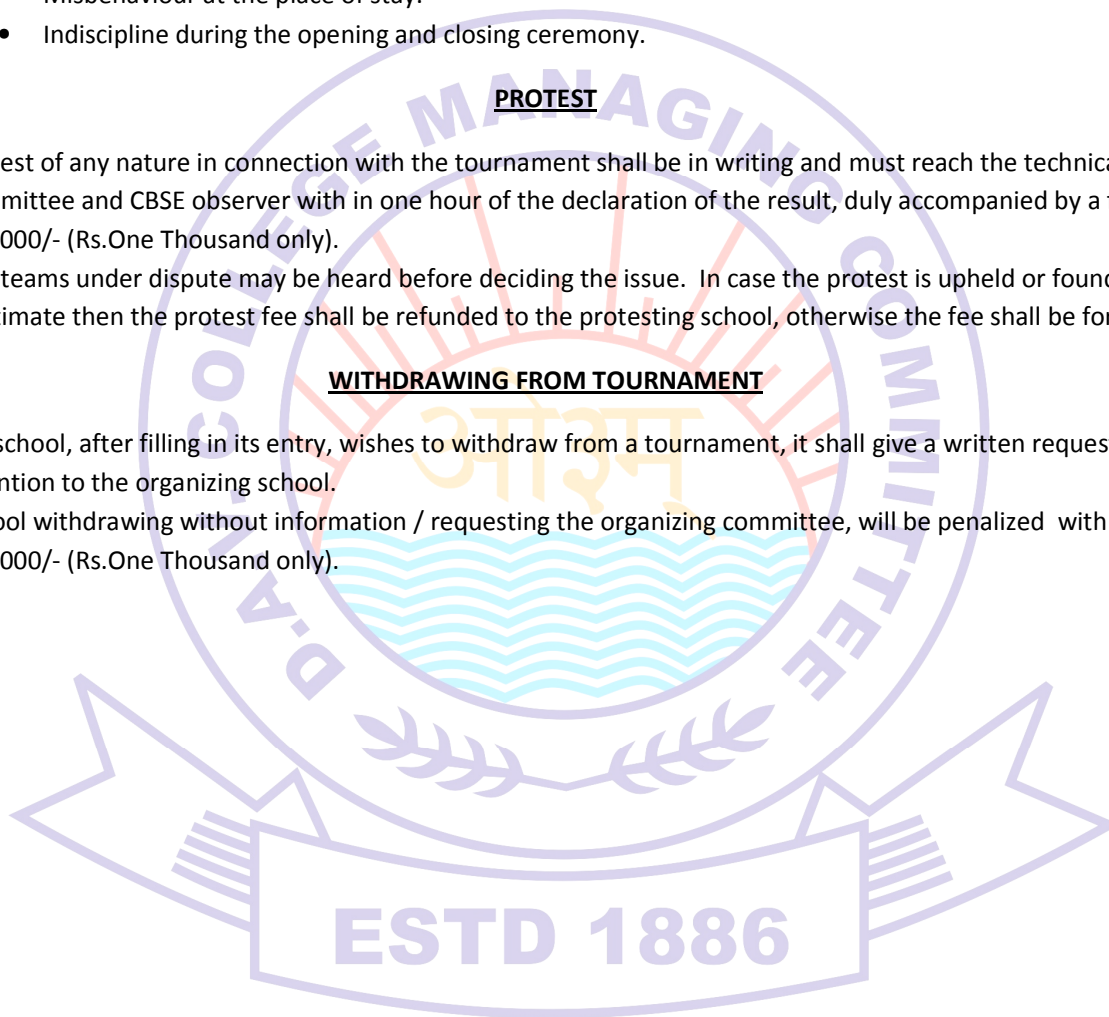
- Ineligibility of any member of the team, if detected.
- Inclusion of non bonafide students in the team.
- Misbehaviour at the place of stay.
- Indiscipline during the opening and closing ceremony.

PROTEST

28. Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the technical committee and CBSE observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs.1000/- (Rs.One Thousand only).
29. The teams under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. In case the protest is upheld or found to be legitimate then the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school, otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

WITHDRAWING FROM TOURNAMENT

30. If a school, after filling in its entry, wishes to withdraw from a tournament, it shall give a written request of its intention to the organizing school.
31. School withdrawing without information / requesting the organizing committee, will be penalized with a fine of Rs.1000/- (Rs.One Thousand only).



SECURITY DEPOSIT

An amount of Rs.2000/- (Rs. Two Thousand only) per school should be deposited at the time of arrival of the team, towards Security Deposit which will be refunded at the time of departure after making deductions, if any, for the damages done to school property by the team.

BOARDING AND LODGING

1. The Boarding and Lodging charges will be Rs.350/- (per day per head). The participants taking one meal in a day shall be charged for the whole day.
2. Minimum three days' boarding and lodging charges will have to be paid in advance.
3. The meal arrangement for all participants will be made within the school campus.
4. Meals will be as per CBSE norms.
5. Timings for meals:
Morning Tea (5.30 a.m. - 6.30 a.m.)
Breakfast (7.00 a.m. - 8.00 a.m.)
Lunch (12.30 p.m. - 2.00 p.m.)
Evening Tea (5.00 p.m. - 6.00 p.m.)
Dinner (8.00 p.m. - 9.30 p.m.)

TRANSPORTATION

1. There will be a reception counter at the **KRISHNA SHILA Railway Station**. Our school bus / vehicle will be available at the Railway Station. The distance from KRISHNASHILLA Railway Station to the venue is 1.5 km. Teams traveling from Lucknow or Varanasi by road may get down at **BINA BUS STAND (near STATE BANK OF INDIA, BINA PROJECT)** which is 0.5 km from the school.
- 2.1 a) The teams coming **via Varanasi** may take UP roadways towards Shaktinagar/ Vindhyannagar depot available 24 hours in every 30 mins. OR
May board train from Varanasi junction (BSB) to KRISHNASHILLA (KRSL) **TRAIN NO.23345 BSB-SKTN LINK INTERCITY EXPRESS AT 14:10 DAILY**
- b) The teams coming via Allahabad may board **TRAIN NO. 24370 TRIVENI EXPRESS, ALLAHABAD JUNCTION (ALD)- 21:25 to KRISHNASHILLA (KRSL) - 07:34 (TUE, THU,SAT, & SUN)**
- 2.2 The teams coming via Allahabad JN (ALD) may also board the following trains from Allahabad Jn. to Renukut (RNQ) which is 36 kms from Bina and 24 hours UP Roadways Buses are available. The trains are as following :
 - a) **TRAIN NO. 12874 ANVT HTE EXPRESS, ALD 04:30 - RNQ 10:30 (WED,THU, & SAT)**
 - b) **TRAIN NO. 18102 JAT MURI TATA EXPRESS, ALD 15:32- RNQ 22:53 (DAILY)**
